Correspondence received:

- 1. Stoneycroft resident asked whether there had been reports of exposure to arsenic by other residents. Clerk forwarded the email to members and advised the parishioner to get in touch with Environmental Health at Dacorum Borough Council.
- 2. D-Day 80th Anniversary 6th June 2024- email circulated to members outlining different ways Aldbury Parish can participate in the commemorations. I suggest this item to be added to the February agenda for discussion.
- 3. HCC Highways had placed advisory signs either side of Tring Station railway bridge. The signs inform that work will be commencing on Monday 8th January that will impact the highway. This work is likely to be the unblocking/repair of the drain outlet that has been causing flooding.
