

Clerk's Report to the Council – Meeting on 4th December 2023

Matters and actions from previous meeting (s):

1. The new noticeboard was delivered and will be installed on the 1st December.
2. Clerk is still waiting for delivery of grit bags which were ordered in September.
3. Outstanding allotment rent is being chased.
4. Filming will be taking place on the 4th and 5th December between 7 am and 7 pm mostly done in two houses. Memorial Hall is hired out as a base for breaks and toilets. The crew will park around the pond area on Monday only and reserved a few parking bays outside the Greyhound. Information letters will be dropped to surrounding properties and there will be members of staff on site throughout the day. The donation fee to the PC is £1,000.

Matters related to December agenda:

Item 23/122 c Report from PCSO Martin Leadbitter – No crimes were reported during November.

23/126 20 mph Zone within Aldbury Parish:

Cllr Houghton contacted the Aldbury school governors who support the 20 mph initiative. The council to consider drafting a letter, that will be also signed by the school governors, asking HCC to include Aldbury Parish in the “20 mph programme in Hertfordshire” (Clerk sent link: www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/20mph)

The Clerk also received correspondence (via 3rd party) and then spoke with the parishioner about speeding on Malting Lane which leaves residents feeling vulnerable, especially when cars drive down the hill near their properties. Residents on Malting Lane would support 20 mph Zone.

23/127 Work to trees.

Correspondence received:
