

Clerk's Report to the Council – Meeting on 8th April 2024

Matters and actions from previous meeting (s):

Matters related to April agenda:

Item 24/046 c Report from PCSO Martin Leadbitter –

During March there have been 2 crimes in the public interest in the Aldbury area both being Theft from Motor Vehicles.

At around 11.35am on 2nd March a Ford Transit van parked on the Ashridge Estate was forcibly broken into causing some damage. The offenders have made off with a number of items including power tools and gardening equipment. This crime remains undetected.

Between 11.00pm on 25th March and 1.00pm on 26th March an offender has removed both number plates from a Blue Mitsubishi Colt parked on New Ground Road before making off. This crime is still under investigation.
